Dear Virginia Union University Alumni and Friends,

On campus, we have been actively monitoring the international, national, and local responses to the COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) pandemic. For nearly two weeks, we have disseminated information via the www.vuu.edu/coronavirus-2020 website informing students on strategies to protect themselves and encouraging students to report self-report their travel plans. Our primary priority is always the health and safety of our campus community. Please accept this correspondence to outline specific decisions we have made to address our collective concerns:

1. Spring Break will be extended, for students, through Saturday, March 21. Students are encouraged to take the extra week to prepare for the return to coursework.
2. Faculty and Staff are to report back to work as regularly scheduled on Monday, March 16.
3. Course instruction will begin on Monday, March 23 via remote course delivery using Microsoft TEAMS and My.VUU.
4. All university-led and hosted events scheduled on and off-campus during the month of March are postponed until further notice.
5. All Spring sports are postponed until further notice.
6. All Enrollment Management recruitment activities will now be hosted virtually.
7. All Alumni Affairs events will be postponed until further notice, while new virtual events will be added to the Panther Tour calendar.

We understand that there may be a number of questions and concerns that arise throughout this experience, and we are prepared to facilitate a timely and consistent response. Please continue to monitor the www.vuu.edu/coronavirus-2020 website for the most up to date information.
